3. CCI World championship Trophy of breeds for young horses

A ranking will be established between stud book members of the WBFSH. The winning stud book is one with the lowest total of penalty points, after adding together the final score of the 3 highest placed competitors (6 year-old result have a coefficient of 0,8 and 7 year-old result have a coefficient of 1). All horses entered to the Championship for young horses are automatically entered to participate to the Championship Trophy of breeds. The entry form must be completed entirely. All information concerning the breeds must be informed. The native stud-books will check the information given on the entry form to take part to the World Championship Trophy of breeds WBFSH.

The entry form must be filled in entirely. It corresponds to the standard norms of the FEI entry, as well as the information requested by the OC for the participation to the World Championship Trophy of breeds WBFSH.

The entry form must be filled in online (Internet) to register the nominative entries of the rider and horse for the participation to the World Championship for Young Eventing horses of 6 and 7.

The OC gives the information to the stud-book for validation.

The stud-book must send the entry back to the OC before the first vet inspection, to be entitled to take part to the Championship Trophy of breeds WBFSH.

IV - Participation / Invitations (Art.107, 108, 120, 507 & Annex 8)

Competitors are invited by the Organising Committee through their NF (Art. 120.1 will apply). Include details of ballot procedure if entries are excessive.

A maximum of 105 horses, of which 35 of 6 years old in the CCI* and 70 of 7 years old in the CCI** without steeple chase, corresponding to the conditions of the art.VI, will be allowed to run.

Must be specified	<p>In case of excessive entries (more than 105 horses), the ballot system will be based on HSBC-FEI World Eventing Rider Rankings, and in the limit of the quota of horse per nation, to be determined on the date of the nominative entries.</p> <p>A working group consisting of the WBFSH, the FEI and the OC will be constituted to evaluate any specific issue which might arise on entries for these championships.</p>

V - REGISTRATION OF RIDERS & HORSES

All Riders & Horses participating in any International Eventing competition must be registered with the FEI. (Art 511.1 & 511.2)

1. EVENTING QUALIFICATION OF COMPETITORS & HORSES (Art.506)

Each NF must certify the qualification of each horse and rider and list the competitions which enabled horse and rider to qualify, according to the qualification procedure established for each star level as laid out in Art.506. Relevant level and criteria must be included in the schedule.

1.1. Principles

In order to compete to an international event, a rider and a horse must have obtained a qualifying result (QR) at a number of events at a lower level.

The requirements are laid out bellow. With the approval of the FEI and their own NF, OCs may impose additional qualifications for horses and/or riders, which must be published in the schedule.

1.2. Qualifying results (QR)

A qualifying result (QR) is achieved by completing a competition within minimum parameters of all round performance. As follows:

- Not more than 75 penalty points in Dressage test; and
- Not more than 20 penalty points at obstacles on the Cross Country Test, and not more than 90 seconds exceeding the optimum time in the Cross. For 4* events, the maximum time by which the optimum time may be exceeded is 120 seconds as from 2005; and
- Not more than 16 penalties at obstacles in the Jumping Test.

1.3. Certification of Qualification for Events

1.3.1. All NF's, including the host nation, are responsible to certify that riders and horses entered by them in international events are correctly qualified in accordance with all the requirements of the Rules.

1.3.2. All qualifying events must be identified, and any national events must be certified as of at least the equivalent standard of difficulty as the relevant international star level of competition.

1.3.3. The Technical Delegate or his nominee shall check that all horses and riders starting at all International events are properly certified as qualified by their NF or duly exempted in accordance with this article.

1.4. Qualifying Period and Deadline

1.4.1. QRs for CIOs, CCIs and CICs must be obtained in the calendar year in question or the 2 preceding calendar years.

1.4.2. The deadline for obtaining the final CIC/CNC QR is 2 weeks before the first Dressage day of the event unless an earlier date is specified in the Schedule. The deadline for obtaining the CCI QR is 4 weeks before the first dressage day of the event unless an earlier date is specified in the Schedule.

1.4.3. Qualifications may be achieved as a combination, 4 weeks before first Dressage day of the event.

All riders and horses participating in any International competition must be registered with the FEI.

3.3 HORSES

- Horses of all riders will be stabled free of charge on the competition grounds from 13th to 19th October 2008.

If stabling is required for a horse that is not competing at the Mondial du Lion, please advise the OC by email mondial-du-lion-hn@haras-nationaux.fr, to know if can be stabled at venue and the conditions.

- Hay and straw: will be provided free of charge (5 kg of hay and 5 kg of straw per horse per day).

Any other kind of bedding (shavings...) will be provided on written request when the definite entries are made and a fee of 60€ paid to the OC (4 Bales to begin with and 1 bale if necessary afterwards).

A number of horse boxes are available for use as tack rooms.
