

## Le Mondial du Lion Equine Hall of Fame

### **FischerRocana FST**

There can surely be no better start to an international championship career for any horse than to win the six year old world Championships at the Mondial du Lion. That is what Rocana (later renamed FischerRocana FST) did in 2011 and not without showing real class – she added no penalties, jumping or time, to her dressage score.

In 2014 she won the individual Bronze medal at the World Equestrian Games held in Normandy, France and went on to show just how profound her talent was by becoming a multiple winner at five star level, victorious at Lexington, Kentucky in three consecutive years, 2015, 2016 and 2017 ... and oh so nearly in 2018 when she came second.

Other admirable five star performances came at Luhmühlen, 2<sup>nd</sup> in 2014 and at Pau, 2<sup>nd</sup> in 2015 and 3<sup>rd</sup> in 2016.

Throughout her career she was ridden by the one and only 'Champion of Everything' Michael Jung who christened her 'Roxie' for less than formal occasions.

Rocana was retired for breeding from 2021 at the family home of the Jung family sharing a paddock with a certain 'Sam' !
