La Biosthetique Sam

A legend in his own time, **La Biosthetique Sam is t**he only horse ever to win individual Gold Medals at two Olympic Games and a World Championship. He is also the first to hold World, Olympic and European titles simultaneously.

'Sam' began his international championship career as a six year old with a Silver Medal at Le Mondial du Lion in 2006. He again won Silver at Le Lion d'Angers in 2007.

He went on to win individual Gold Medals at the World Equestrian Games 2010 at Lexington, Kentucky, the London Olympic Games in 2012 and the Rio de Janeiro Olympics in 2016.

La Biosthetique Sam also completed seven times at five star level winning on three occasions :

He began his retirement in 2018 at the home of the Jung family where, in the words of Michael « *He will continue to be ridden and treated like the champion he is.* »

Why aren't there more horses like Sam? Well one reason might be that in 2002 the stallion licensing committee at Marbach turned him down - they considered he lacked in quality !
