

LE MONDIAL DU LION 2025: A BOLD ANNIVERSARY, OPEN TO ALL AUDIENCES

From October 16 to 19, 2025, the Mondial du Lion will celebrate its 40th edition.

Forty years of competition, evolution, and ambition with one goal: to offer an international equestrian event rooted in its territory and open to everyone.

The Mondial du Lion has always remained true to its mission: bringing all generations together around a world-class equestrian competition in a festive, welcoming, and meaningful atmosphere. Whether you're a sports enthusiast, a family, a curious visitor, or just passing through — this event is made for you.

STAYING INTERNATIONAL, STAYING AMBITIOUS

In 2025, like many sporting events, the Mondial du Lion must adapt to reduced public funding. Nevertheless, there is no question of compromising on the fundamentals that make the event what it is: sporting excellence, high-quality hospitality, safety, and a memorable experience for the public. Finding a new balance is key to preserving the event's international ambition. Every year, the Mondial welcomes nearly 45,000 spectators, relies on 300 volunteers, and hosts more than 110 riders from 25 nations.

2025 PROGRAMME – DAY BY DAY

Thursday, October 16 & Friday, October 17

- Dressage phase (free entry)
- School groups welcomed in the “P'tits Lions” zone, with educational workshops on the equestrian world, the environment, and living beings
- A calmer atmosphere ideal for families and curious visitors who wish to discover the Mondial at their own pace, outside the weekend crowds

Saturday, October 18

- Cross-country phase — the highlight of the eventing competition — on a 5 km course through the park
- The most spectacular and popular day, with entertainment throughout the site
- Early-bird rate of €24 (instead of €26) available until June 29

Sunday, October 19

- Show jumping finale in the main arena
- Closing day with the crowning of world champions
- Wide range of tickets available, from €11 to €70, including access to the new pedestrian zone at the foot of the grandstand for a close-up experience

Every day, visitors can enjoy:

- A reorganized village for easier browsing and better interaction with exhibitors
- Live music performances
- A dedicated family area: the “P’tits Lions” zone with free activities for children

WHAT’S NEW IN 2025

For this anniversary edition, several improvements have been introduced to enhance visitor experience:

- **A new layout for the Village**

The 2025 Village has been reimagined to offer a smoother, more enjoyable experience. Redesigned as a real living space, it now makes it easier to move around, better organize exhibitor zones, and integrate rest, dining, and entertainment areas. The goal: make strolling more intuitive, offer more discovery moments, and showcase local expertise and event partners under optimal conditions.

- **New pedestrian zone near the jumping arena**

A new pedestrian area at the foot of the grandstand allows visitors without assigned seating to get closer to the action during Sunday’s show jumping. With direct views of the main arena, it expands the existing offer and responds to a growing demand for affordable yet immersive experiences.

- **Continued access for school groups to the “P’tits Lions” zone**

On Thursday and Friday, school groups will again be welcomed in the educational “P’tits Lions” area. The program includes awareness workshops on the equestrian world, sustainability, and biodiversity, organized with local associations.
